G20 and Anti-Corruption: Stalled progress at Summit

The G20 leaders lost an opportunity to make progress on implementation and enforcement of anti-corruption principles. The Coalition for Integrity notes that at the Summit, the G20 [endorsed](#) four sets of high level principles aimed at fostering integrity in the public and private sectors. Adopting principles, however, is the easy part.

We believe the G20 need to take meaningful action to address bribery and corruption. Unfortunately, the G20 has failed once again to follow up on the commitment that all G20 countries become signatories to the OECD Anti-Bribery convention.
