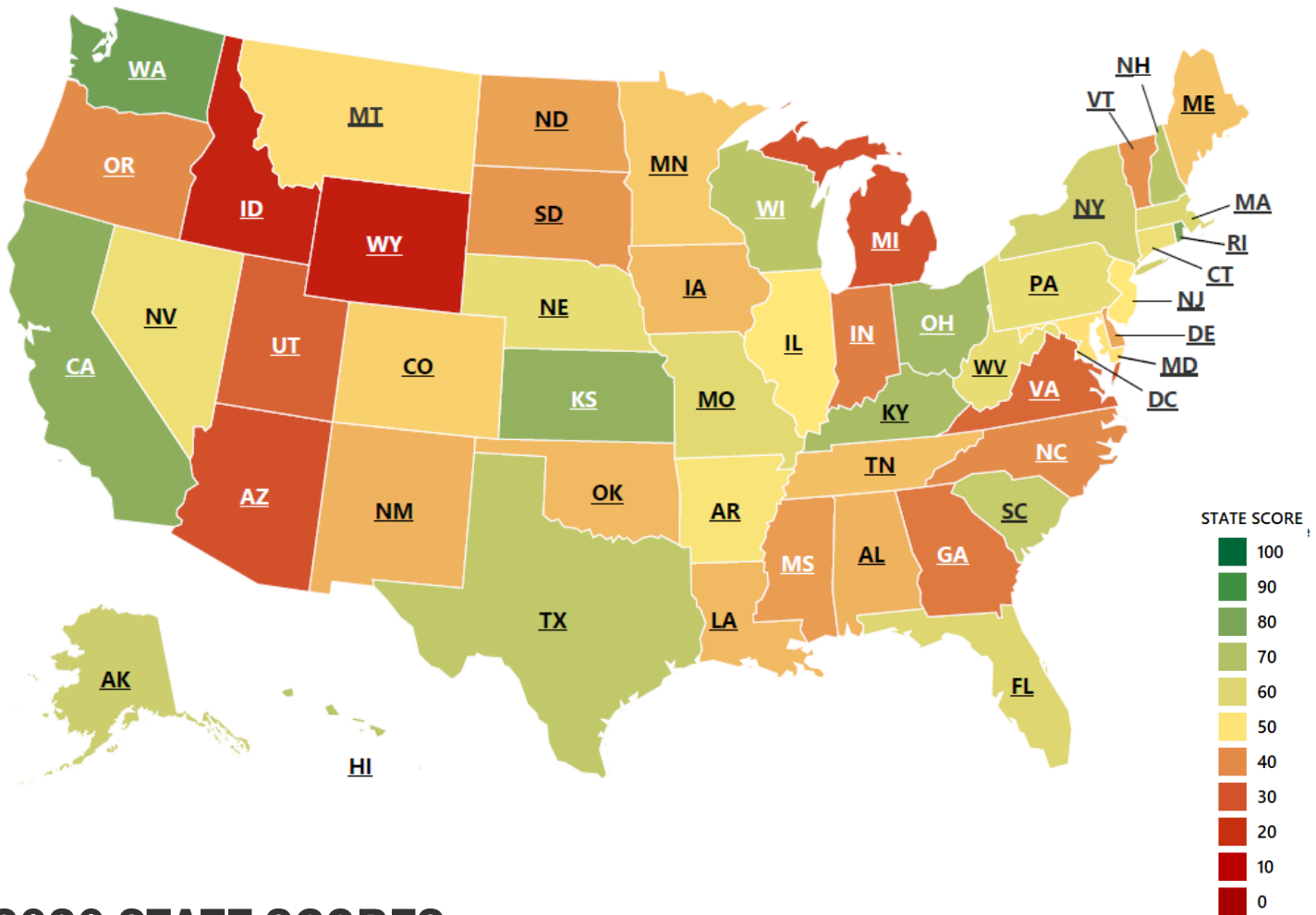




The S.W.A.M.P. Index 2020
